

Senior Yearbook Information

Senior photos appear in two special sections of the yearbook.

Senior portraits appear in the portrait of the book. We often try to include two photos of each senior in this section. It is helpful if you submit three or more photos from which we may choose. These photos are taken by a skilled photographer and must follow the dress code as specified below.

Men:

- Hair must not touch eyebrows, ears, or collar.
- Necklaces are not permitted.
- Facial hair is not permitted.
- Shirts must have a collar.
- Generally, colored shirts are more attractive than all black or all white.

Ladies:

- Tops may not be low enough to show cleavage.
- Tops may not be sleeveless. Cap sleeves are permitted, but please avoid open shoulder styles.
- In full body poses, dresses must cover the knees.
- Generally, colored tops are more attractive than all black or all white. Tops may not have words or pictures on them.

Senior ads appear in the back of the book. In this section, parents purchase ad space and submit a variety of photos depending on the size of the ad. These photos usually include baby pictures, family photos, and special moments in the senior's growing-up years. Along with these photos, parents usually add text to congratulate, honor, and encourage their senior.

Photography Requests:

1. One Formal Portrait (head shot)

- Guys should wear a collared shirt or a collared shirt with a tie; girls should wear school blouse or dress (must have sleeves and a modest neckline). Caps and gowns are also acceptable.
- We prefer digital! – Please submit digital pictures with a resolution of 300 dpi or better to ensure good print quality.
- Hard copies size 4" x 6" are acceptable. Smaller sizes may become blurred. **Please send duplicate copies, not the only original.**

2. Two Informal Pictures

- Please follow school field trip dress guidelines (girls' tops must have sleeves and modest necklines; no shorts).
- One of these photos may include family members or friends
